

6th, 1891, for the purpose of effecting a permanent organization. At this meeting committees were appointed to plan the organization and to draw up the articles of the association. On December 15, 1891, a meeting was called at the Chapel, and the permanent articles of organization were adopted, and the following officers were elected: Charles Treat, president; Charles H. Sanford, Darwin Keeler, George Minor, Smith R. Weeks, Eli Sturdevant, directors; Eli Sturdevant, secretary, treasurer and sexton; and William Welton, collector.
